2021 FLOWER SHOW

RULES:

- 1) There will be two shows. Show #1, for specimens and potted plants, will be held on Wednesday, September 1, 2021. Show #2, for roses, gladiolus, houseplants, and arrangements will be on Saturday, September 4, 2021. Junior show is on the same day as for the adults (senior division).
- 2) These shows are open to amateur gardeners only. Commercial gardeners and professional designers are prohibited.
- 3) **ENTRY FORMS AND FEES MUST BE ENTERED AT THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY BY 6:00 PM, SUNDAY, AUGUST 29, 2021.**
- 4) Fee will be \$1.00 per entry.
- 5) Specimens and potted plants for Show #1 must be in place by 12:00 PM (noon) on Wednesday, September 1, 2021. Judging will start at 1:00 PM beginning with the Junior Division.
- 6) Specimens and arrangements for Show #2, must be in place by 11:00 AM on Saturday, September 4, 2021. Judging will start at 12:00 PM (noon) beginning with the Junior Division.
- 7) All entries for Section 1 from Show #1 must be removed by 7:00 PM on Friday, September 3, 2021 to make room for Show #2. All other entries must remain until 3:00 PM on Monday, September 6, 2021
- 8) All exhibits will be judged by a person accredited by the Ohio Association of Garden Clubs (OAGC) and follow OAGC rules for exhibiting. Per general Richwood Fair rules, no person shall interfere with the judge or awarding committee.
- 9) Management assumes no responsibility for loss, damage or accidents.

SHOW ONE – WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2021

SPECIMEN RULES

- 1) Specimens **MUST HAVE BEEN GROWN BY THE EXHIBITOR.**
- 2) Exhibitors must furnish their own clear glass container, size suitable for exhibit.
- 3) All horticultural specimens should have a variety name written on the front of the entry tag, if possible. Lack of a name will not bar the specimen.
- 4) Exhibit must contain the number of blooms, sprays or stems specified in the schedule.
- 5) In classes calling for several blooms, select flowers in uniform size and color.
- 6) An exhibitor may make as many entries as desired in any class, providing each is a different color/named variety.
- 7) The staging committee reserves the right to combine, subdivide or delete a class, if necessary.
- 8) The decision of the judge is final.

1. Asters, any variety, one bloom, disbudded
2. Dahlia, any variety over 8", one bloom, disbudded
3. Dahlia, any variety 4" to 8", one bloom, disbudded

5. Dahlia, any variety, pompons under 2", 3 blooms, disbudded
6. Lantana, one spray, any variety
7. Marigold, carnation flowered, orange, one bloom, disbudded

SECTION 2 – EVERLASTING

SECTION 7 – POTTED PLANTS

RULES:

- 1) Plant must be exhibited in the container in which it was grown.
 - 2) Plant exhibited must have been grown by the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
 - 3) Unless stated otherwise, each pot exhibited must contain only one plant.
 - 4) Fern stands will be provided for class 96 and 97 if needed.
 - 5) This section will be exhibited outside with the exception of classes 105 and 106.

111. Hybrid Tea, any variety, pink or pink blend, one bloom, disbudded with foliage attached
112. Hybrid Tea, any variety, red or red blend, one bloom, disbudded with foliage attached
113. Hybrid Tea, any variety, orange, orange-red, or orange blend, one bloom, disbudded with foliage attached
114. Hybrid Tea, any variety, any other color not listed above, one bloom, disbudded with foliage attached

RULES:

- 1) Plant must be exhibited in the container in which it was grown.
- 2) Plant exhibited must have been grown by the exhibitor for at least 3 months.
- 3) Unless stated otherwise, each pot exhibited must contain only one plant.

SECTION 11 – ARTISTIC ARRANGMENTS

RULES:

- 1) The exhibitor may place only one entry in each class, and it must be the work of that exhibitor.
- 2) Plant material for artistic designs may be secured from any source. Emphasis is on freshly grown garden materials from the exhibitor's garden.
- 3) Painted or artificially colored fresh plant material is not permitted.
- 4) Additional foliage, accessories, mats, backgrounds, and dried materials may be used in all classes.
- 5) Artificial plant material is not permitted in any class.

THEME: HOME SWEET HOME

143. The Front Door – a wreath of live plants and/or flowers (will be displayed outside, under cover)

144. The Fireplace – an illuminated design (a three-dimensional design incorporating light(s) as one of the components; electric source will be supplied if needed)

145. The Garden – a design incorporating flowers and/or foliage, and uncut fruits and/or vegetables

146. The Kitchen – a mass design in a cooking container

147. The Dining Room – a round mound design not to exceed 12 inches high

148. The Décor – a creative design using 1 to 3 flower(s)

149. The Nursery – a miniature design not to exceed 5 inches in any direction

JUNIOR DIVISION

RULES:

1. Junior exhibitors will abide by all rules specified for the adult sections.
2. Junior exhibitors should have been involved in the planting and caring for their specimen or potted plant entry.
3. Junior exhibitor's artistic design must be their own creation. An adult may help in selecting the proper materials and give guidance but must allow the junior exhibitor to complete the design.
4. Junior classes will be divided in two sections (age must be on entry tag):
 - a. Section A will be for exhibitors in 11 to 17 years old (typically grades 6 – 12)
 - b. Section B will be for exhibitors 10 years old and under (typically 5th grade and under).

150. Marigold, large, any variety/color, one bloom, disbudded, foliage attached
151. Marigold, petite, any variety/color, one spray, not disbudded, foliage attached
152. Zinnia, large, any variety/color, one bloom, disbudded, foliage attached
153. Zinnia, small flowered, under 2", any color, 3 blooms of the same variety
154. Sunflower, fresh cut in water, any variety/color, one stem
155. Sunflower seed head over 6" on a white paper plate, without petals, disc florets removed
156. Any foliage potted plant, single plant
157. Any flowering potted plant, single plant
158. Fairy Garden (must have at least one fairy figurine displayed), may have more than one plant
159. Terrarium, container not to exceed 12 inches in width, may contain more than one plant

ARTISTIC ARRANGEMENTS

SECTION A:

160. My Music – an interpretive design inspired by your favorite song (must list song title and explain interpretation on 3x5 card)
161. Lightening Bug – an illuminated design (a three-dimensional design incorporating light(s) as one of the components; electric source will be supplied if needed)

SECTION B:

162. Backyard Critter – create a critter using any combination of flowers, foliage, fruits and/or vegetables (must name/identify the critter on a 3x5 card)
163. Mom's Bouquet – a fresh cut bouquet of flowers in a clear glass vase/container of water
