## Rules of Eligibility:

- 1. Entry Fee: \$20 per head.
- 2. Animals may enter fairgrounds on Friday, September 1st between 12 Noon and 9:00pm or on Saturday, September 2nd after 7:00am.
- 3. All calves must be in place by Saturday, September 2nd at 2:00pm.
- 4. All calves must be registered and weighed in between 12:00pm-2:00pm on Saturday, September 2nd.
- 5. All calves will be weighed and divided into the divisions and classes shown below.
- 6. All calves will be released after the show.
- 7. Calves must be sired by a beef bull.
- 8. Heifers and steers must be born after January 1, 2023 and weigh no more than 899 pounds.
- 9. No limit of animals per exhibitor.
- 10. It is required that calves be de-horned and castrated.
- 11. Out-of-State calves must have a Health Certificate from a certified veterinarian in compliance with Ohio State health regulations.
- 12. All calves must be broke to lead and show.
- 13. The Beef Committee reserves the right to reject any calf that does not meet physical requirements as to size, age, quality, etc. All decisions of the committee are final.
- 14. Premiums are based on a 50 calf show. Premiums will be pro-rated on less than a 50 calf show.
